CONDITIONS RELATING TO BURNING TIMES

6. The following conditions shall be attached to each permit:

{1} No person, with or without a permit, shall burn during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday inclusive from 12:01 a.m. to 5:59 p.m. (including holidays)

OTHER CONDITIONS

7. The following conditions shall be attached to each permit:

{a} No materials other than clean wood waste, natural brush, cuttings or lawn rakings are to be burned;

{b} A fire shall not be lighted, ignited or started within 10 meters of a residence;

{c} A fire shall not be started when the wind is gusting;

{d} Sufficient help must be engaged, and care taken, to prevent the fire from spreading;

{e} Every fire shall be attended at all times, by a competent person, until completely extinguished;

{f} The person attending the fire shall have at hand adequate fire extinguishing apparatus.

{g} A permit may only be granted for a period of one week.

{h} No burning may occur within 100 meters of woods, brush, etc.
