i. Valley Regional Services – Dan McDougall

Mr. McDougall presented an update on the new Valley Waste (VW) and Kings Transit Authority (KTA) service agreements with the Municipality of the County of Annapolis, joining both WV and KTA and the District of Digby joining KTA. They reviewed the new costing formula for KTA with the Town of Annapolis having a separate agreement with the Municipality of the County of Annapolis and not being a partner of KTA. The Valley Waste funding formula remains the same as the current formula. The presentation also included updates on dispute resolution, assets and borrowing procedures, supplementary services, and withdrawal and dissolution procedures.

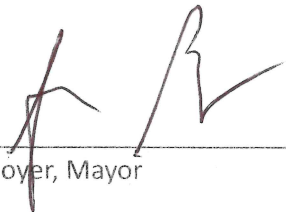

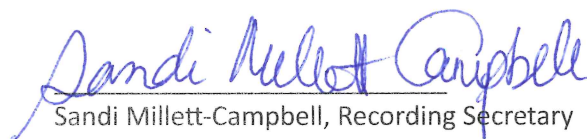
